INTERSTATE COMMISSION FOR EMS PERSONNEL PRACTICE RULES COMMITTEE MEETING – VIA PHONE/WEB

March 27, 2018

Meeting called to order by Chairman Denny at 4:01p.m. EDT

Guy Danise made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 20, 2018, meeting. The motion was seconded by Jeanne-Marie Bakehouse.

Motion Passed 4-0

Discussion on Section 3. HOME STATE LICENSURE, Subsection C.4

The Committee continued the review and discussion of the DRAFT document with language for “Chapter 3: Member State Background Check.” Rick Masters expressed concerns about the DRAFT and offered the following comments:

- The purpose of the background check needs to be stated.
- The federal law which enables the background check should be referenced PL US 92.544.
- That this DRAFT language does not connect as a reference point with SECTION 3. HOME STATE LICENSURE. Language such as this would belong under SECTION 4. PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE.

Members of the Committee understood that FBI background check findings cannot be shared. The purpose of the DRAFT rule would be procedural specific to the verification that a check has been completed at the time of initial licensure in member states.

The Committee discussed what a “restricted” versus “unrestricted” license means in the setting of a privilege to practice and what the definition of Home State means. Further discussion and development of language of both these items needs follow up from the Committee.

Chair Denny has been developing a graphic that depicts SECTION 5. CONDITIONS OF PRACTICE IN A REMOTE STATE. Discussion followed. Chair Denny will forward the graphic to the Commission Chairman Joe Schmider.
